




What do you think are the strengths of our SEND?

- > The support offered to individuals is very tailored and specific allowing achievable goals to be set.
- > There is a wide support network available.
- > Mrs Curtis is very helpful and proactive.
- > Feedback from teachers daily is very helpful.
- > Helping children achieve their potential.
- > Making children understand nothing is out of their reach.
- > Reassure children at all times.
- > I am happy with all information.
- > Good communication.
- > Act when you say you will act.
- > Review and change if required.
- > Keep my daughter informed.
- > She does not feel like the odd one out.
- > The teachers are nice and my son enjoys school.

What would you like to see improved about our SEND practise?

- Communication it would be nice to receive regular feedback from staff without having to wait for parent's evenings or for parents to make appointments.
- > Clear feedback should be regular and with the staff involved.
 - ✓ We provide regular feedback to parents through our three academic reports and our attitude to learning report as well as meeting with parents to discuss the three support plans we implement throughout the academic year which are often discussed in detail at parent's evenings. Additionally, you are always welcome in school to make an appointment to discuss your child.
 - ✓ In the future, we are looking to offer to all parents of SEND children an increased time slot at parent's evenings to allow for a fuller discussion of your child's needs without the current time constraints.

- > More feedback on additional sessions such as SALT and group sessions.
 - ✓ We pass onto you through the support plan meeting any feedback and information we receive from any outside agency. Interventions that are delivered by school are evaluated by the staff involved and this informs current and future support plans.
 - Outside agencies routinely send reports to parents and we are not always involved in this process.

> One on one help

- ✓ This is not always in the best interests of the child for their
 academic, social or physical development. However, if it is deemed
 appropriate for their development, children will work one-to-one
 with staff.
- ✓ Financially, this is unsustainable in the long term and can only be used for short intensive interventions.
